

# Delta Electronics Slovakia 2025 Overseas

## Professional Internship Program Announcement

Updated on June 1, 2024

- **Program Execution Time and Location**
  1. Internship Duration: From February to July 2025, totaling 6 months.
  2. Internship Location: Delta Electronics Slovakia Factory (Dubnica, Slovakia)
  3. Internship Positions:
    - Process Engineer (Automation)**
    - NPI and R&D Support Engineer**
- **Application Eligibility and Process**
  1. Eligibility: Current graduate students at NCKU, with priority given to those in related fields.
  2. Application Process: Submit your Chinese and English resumes online during the application period (from now until September 30, 2024) at <https://careers.smartrecruiters.com/DeltaElectronics>. Each student can only apply for one internship position.
  3. Language Requirement: English is the primary language for communication during the overseas internship. Applicants must have proficiency in English listening, speaking, reading, and writing. The entire company interview will be conducted in English.
  4. Interview and Selection: Preliminary selection will be conducted in mid-October by the company, and the results will be announced by the end of October.
  5. Application Timeline:
    - (1) Now to September 30: Application period
    - (2) October 1 to October 10: Preliminary qualification review
    - (3) October 14 to October 18: Internship briefing and HR English re-examination for students who pass the preliminary review
    - (4) October 21 to October 25: Supervisor interview (online re-examination)
    - (5) October 30: Announcement of admission results
    - (6) November 1 to November 8: Submission of visa application documents
    - (7) February 1, 2025: Start of the six-month internship
- **Scholarships and Benefits**
  1. Provided by the Company:

- (1) Internship Stipend: €700 per month before tax.
  - (2) Accommodation: Provided by the company during the internship period.
  - (3) Visa Application Assistance: The company will assist students in applying for an internship work visa (\*please refer to Student Notice 4 for details).
2. Provided by NCKU:
    - (1) Flight Subsidy: Subsidy for round-trip direct economy class airfare, limited to one time.
    - (2) Official School Documents: Provision of official school documents required for applying for an internship work visa from the Slovak government.
- **Student Notes**
    1. Internship Location: The internship will take place in Slovakia. Due to internship tasks, students may need to travel to other countries for short-term business trips. Students must hold a valid passport, and their short-term travel must comply with the company's internal management policies.
    2. Safety and Conduct: Slovakia is generally safe, and locals are friendly to foreigners. However, students should always be mindful of their own safety, adhere to local laws and company regulations, and be responsible for their actions. In case of major emergencies or urgent incidents, students can seek assistance from local consulates.
    3. Stipend and Expenses: Both NCKU and the company will provide a living stipend or subsidy. However, students are responsible for covering their own living expenses, accommodation, transportation, local health insurance, and personal income taxes. Any shortfall must be covered by the students themselves. After completing the internship, students are expected to attend and report at the debriefing session organized by NCKU.
    4. Visa Application: The local government has the authority to approve or deny visas. If the visa application is denied, the student's overseas internship program will be terminated. The visa processing time is approximately 3-4 months, with a definite result expected by the end of January (subject to the local government's actual processing time).
