目標

為利大專校院教師在以英語作為教學媒介（EMI）的教學現場具備更多元之技巧與實務工具，國立中興大學 EMI 教學資源中心（以下簡稱本中心）與英國牛津全英語授課訓練中心（Oxford EMI Ltd，以下簡稱牛津）合作辦理 2024 年全英語授課增能工具專案，期藉由牛津 EMI 培訓團隊開發之影片和素材傳授不同教學法，增進教師 EMI 教學品質，並提升 EMI 課程的學習成效，完成本專案之教師可獲得牛津頒發之 Oxford EMI 電子證書。

三、專案內容

NCHU EMI Teaching and Learning Center: 2024 English Medium Instruction Enhancement Tools Project

Article 1 Basis

Ministry of Education's subsidy for the National Chung Hsing University "EMI Teaching and Learning Center" project.

Article 2 Objectives



To help university teachers develop more diverse skills and practical tools for English as a Medium of Instruction (EMI) teaching, the National Chung Hsing University EMI Teaching and Learning Center (hereinafter referred to as "the Center") is collaborating with Oxford EMI Ltd (hereinafter referred to as "Oxford") to implement the 2024 EMI Enhancement Tools Project. Through videos and materials developed by Oxford's EMI training team, the project aims to teach various pedagogical methods, improve teachers' EMI teaching quality, and enhance EMI course learning outcomes. Teachers who complete this project will receive an Oxford EMI electronic certificate.



Article 3 Project Content

1. Content Overview: This project consists of four modules: "An Interactive Approach to Teaching Module," "Understanding the Role of Language in the Classroom Module," "EMI Teaching Skills Module," and "Classroom Management and Integration Module." Please refer to [Attachment 1] for related information.
2. Course Duration: From the date of key activation until Thursday, July 31, 2025, totaling 30-40 hours.
3. Target Participants: EMI teachers from all disciplines at universities and colleges are eligible to apply.
4. Equipment Requirements: A smartphone, tablet, laptop, or desktop computer capable of properly viewing and listening to videos. It is recommended that the hardware device's browser be updated to the latest version.
5. Completion Requirements: This project is conducted through asynchronous online learning. Participating teachers can complete the four modules online at any time and location within the course period (until July 31, 2025). Upon completion, they will receive an Oxford EMI electronic certificate.

Article 4 Review and Subsidy Principles

1. Registration Period: Until Tuesday, December 31, 2024. Registration will close early if the quota is filled.
2. Maximum Number of Participants: 50 people.

3. Registration Method: Online registration only; application form available at <https://forms.gle/hA5eS4Hs4tcGUQyX7>. Please refer to [Attachment 2] for registration information.
4. Review and Notification: The Center's Project Director and Project Executive Director will review the application forms. Results will be sent directly to applicants' email addresses.
5. Subsidy Principle: The National Chung Hsing University "EMI Teaching and Learning Center" project funds cover the course fees for this project.

Article 5 Project Monitoring and Completion



1. Teachers must complete all four project modules within the course period (from the key activation date until July 31, 2025).
2. After completing the course, teachers must complete a feedback form (<https://forms.gle/Vr478JLQ9xGdQVSPA>) within one week.
3. After completing the training, Participants agree to be included in the Center's EMI teacher talent pool.

The 4 English Medium Instruction Modules**I. Module 1: English Medium Instruction (EMI): An Interactive Approach to Teaching**

In Module 1, we ask course participants to think about their current academic teaching context. What kind of classes do they teach and how do they approach their teaching? We then look at the theories of how adults learn, how this affects the way we teach and how this compares with current teaching approaches in universities around the world.

We continue by exploring what the research tells us about the growing global phenomenon of EMI and what motivates the different stakeholders; governments, institutions, lecturers and students.

Teaching and learning in EMI needs to become more interactive and motivating. Supported by research into Education, we focus on how to achieve this in an international university setting to deliver excellent results in EMI.

II. Module 2: Understanding the Role of Language in the Classroom

In Module 2, we start by analysing a university EMI class and the language issues that arise. We then look at how lecturers utilise their current level of English to explain complex academic content, resolve issues and help their students understand. Participants learn how to modify their speech and texts; how to teach technical terms and academic language. We explore how to measure students' English ability, so that lecturers can adjust their lecture delivery appropriately. This ensures that students learn high-level academic content successfully.

Module 3: EMI Teaching Skills

In Module 3, we focus on teaching techniques and improving interaction in EMI classes including large classes. Participants learn and practice using the IRF framework. How do we ask questions which involve all of the students, force students to think, and allow us to check understanding? How do we utilise the Wait Time concept in an EMI context? We answer these questions by observing an EMI class, identifying the teaching techniques and suggesting new approaches.

We provide ideas and practical solutions for creating interaction even in large classes. How to incorporate technology to facilitate interaction, the use of Brief Interactive Tasks (BITS) and how these can help with comprehension and the development of soft skills.

Module 4: Classroom Management and Integration

In this final module, we focus on ensuring that teaching through English maintains the high level of cognitive challenge that we associate with good university lectures. We show how the IRF framework can be expanded and used to make students think deeply and critically.



EMI classes are often international. This means that we need to ensure that students joining from abroad are fully integrated into the classroom and have a positive experience in the institution. Participants learn techniques for effective classroom management for integrating international students into the academic subject. Finally, we give real life examples of best practice in EMI.



This course comprises 40 hours of study.
